Workshops

Family Support & Wellbeing Service

Edullect Academy hosted a special Wellbeing workshop for parents, led by our in house Family & Couples Support Practitioner and Islamic Scholar, Mrs Mücahide Güngördü. The session provided practical strategies to help families better understand children's emotional needs, foster positive family communication, and strengthen both parent-child and spousal relationships. Parents also received guidance on encouraging positive behaviour and wellbeing at home.

Early Years Maths Workshop

We held an early Years Maths Workshop for parents and children. This session gave parents an overview of how mathematics is taught in the early years. Teachers shared practical ways they can support their child(ren)'s learning at home. Parents observed and took part in activities with children, experiencing how maths is taught in the classroom using different materials. The workshop was thoroughly enjoyed by both parents and children.



Understanding Early Years Workshop

We also hosted the Understanding the Early Years workshop, led by our EYFS Lead and School SENCO, Mrs. Theresa Hedoun. This informative session welcomed all parents and focused on helping them understand the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) for children aged 0-5 years. Parents were introduced to the Statutory Framework for the EYFS, gaining valuable insight into age-related expectations and child development. The workshop was very well received by parents.

Science Curriculum Meeting - PSHE

The recent Science Curriculum meeting, held to introduce the new PSHE topic, was a positive and productive session. To ensure accessibility, the meeting was offered in a hybrid format, with some parents attending in person and others joining remotely. The presentation slides were also shared with all parents afterward. We were very pleased to receive full parental support, with no objections raised regarding the sensitive content or the planned delivery methods.
