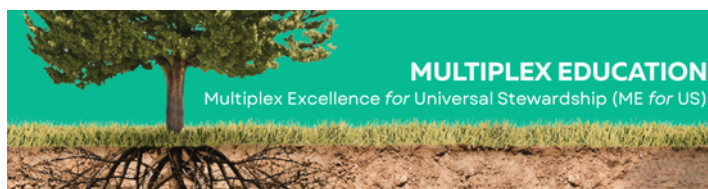
## Introducing Multiplex Education: A New Era for Learning at Edullect Academy

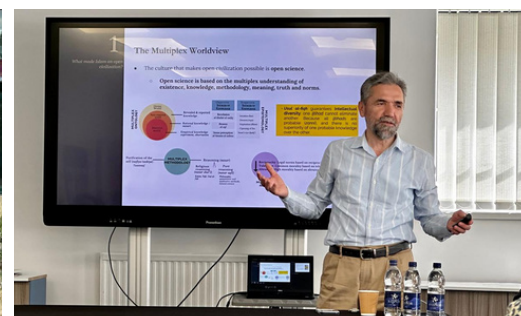
## Sports Day!

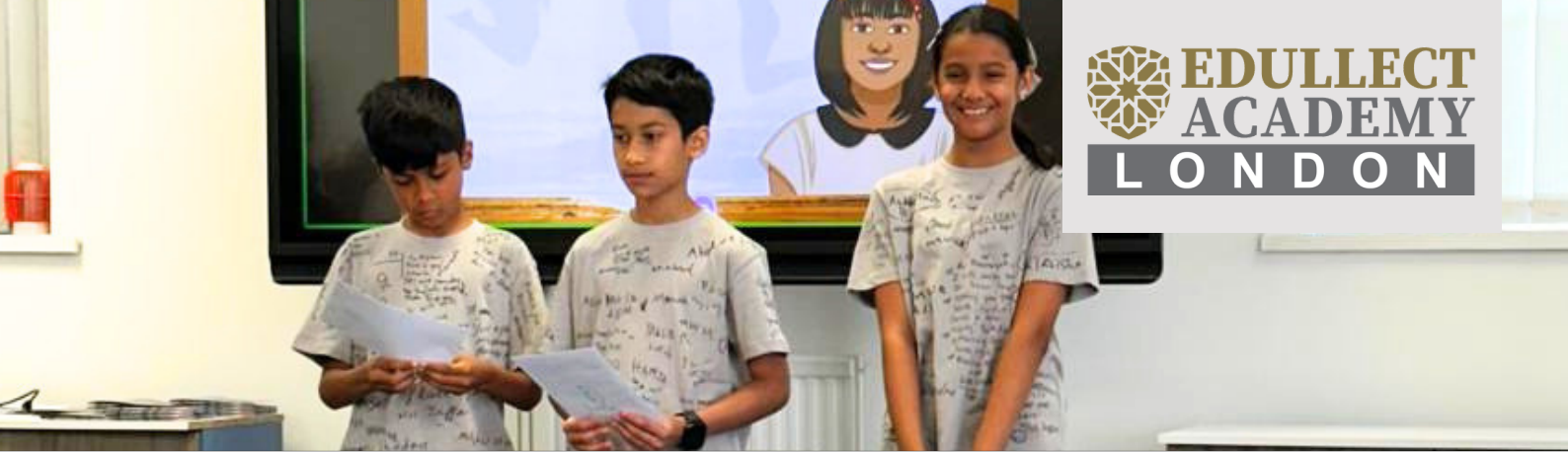
